Mojave Water Agency Featured June 30 on PBS Show

Apple Valley, CA—Viewers tuning in to view the PBS show, *Curiosity Quest* on June 30th will learn about the science behind Mojave Water Agency's management of the High Desert's water resources. The show will air locally on June 30 at 3:30 p.m. on channel KVCR.

The show hosted by Joel Greene is titled, "Water Conservation: Is it Rocket Science?" It features a tour throughout the MWA service area at key locations and includes a demonstration at the Deep Creek Recharge site in Apple Valley, conservation programs at Barstow and Victor Valley community colleges, well testing, and a biology lesson in the Morongo Valley.

"The program provides a great overview of how MWA working with our local communities manages our vital water resources here in the Mojave Desert," said Yvonne Hester, MWA spokeswoman. "While the program is aimed at a school-age audience, it's informative and fun for all ages."

The Mojave Water Agency manages the region's water resources for the common benefit to assure stability in the sustained use for its citizens. It is one of 29 State Water Contractors that is entitled to receive State Water Project water when available. The Agency's territory encompasses 4,900 squares miles with a population of 450,000.
