Mojave Water Agency offers full calendar of 2024 events

Apple Valley, CA — Mojave Water Agency has released its 2024 schedule of events, activities and classes. Events are free to the public and include a mix of in-person and virtual options.

For starters, the online From Seeds to Salad course begins Jan. 25 and runs weekly until May 2. This is one of many online public education workshops offered in partnership with the Mojave Desert Resource Conservation District (MDRCD). Online registrations are still available.

The additional upcoming MDRCD online classes include:

- Native Plant Gardening, Mar. 12
- Summarizing to Save Water, Apr. 2
- Soil Composting, Mulching, and Soil Amendments, Oct. 10
- Native Plant Cuttings Propagations Class, Oct. 24
- Winterizing to Save Water, Nov. 7

The in-person Wonders of Water series of workshops returns this year to bring awareness about current climate, industry and weather events and presented by staff experts and members of the local community. This year's scheduled classes will be held on March 5, July 9, September 10 and November 5. All classes are held at Agency Headquarters in Apple Valley from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Our first Road Show (formerly known as our Mini Tour) will be offered on Saturday, May 18, with a fall date scheduled on Oct. 17. These half-day bus tours visit local facilities and are hosted by MWA staff. We expect the Saturday event to fill up fast so register soon.

Lastly, the Agency's upcoming Innovators High Desert Water Summit will take place on Feb. 9. This is a great opportunity for science and literature students to learn more about the water industry, careers in water and network with college level instructors. This event is free and open to schools within the Agency's service area. Bus stipends are available for schools to attend, and lunch is included.
