Mojave Water Agency provides full calendar of 2025 events

Apple Valley, CA — Mojave Water Agency has released its 2025 schedule of events, activities and classes. Events are free to the public and include a mix of in-person and virtual options.

The online From Seed to Salad course begins Jan. 30 and runs weekly until May 8. This is one of many online public education workshops offered in partnership with the Mojave Desert Resource Conservation District (MDRCD). Online registration is still available.

The additional upcoming MDRCD online classes include:

- Summer Irrigation Conservation, April 8
- Rain Harvesting and Storm Water, July 10
- Seed Bank Basics for Beginners, Aug. 28
- ADA-Friendly Water Wise Gardening, Oct. 2
- Winter Irrigation Conservation, Nov. 6

The in-person Wonders of Water series of workshops returns this year to bring awareness about current climate, industry and weather events and presented by staff experts and members of the local community. This year's scheduled classes will be held on March 4, July 15, and Sept. 2. All classes are held at Agency Headquarters in Apple Valley from 5:30 to 7 p.m. The July 15 Wonders of Water will be a family-themed event catered to kids and young adults.

Our MWA Road Show (formerly known as our Mini Tour) will be offered on March 19. This half-day bus tour will visit local facilities hosted by MWA staff. Space is limited and expected to fill fast so early registration is encouraged.

The Agency's upcoming Innovators High Desert Water Summit will take place on Feb. 7. This is a great opportunity for science and literature students to learn more about the water industry, careers in water and network with college level instructors. Although currently sold out, the event is free and open to schools within the Agency's service area. A recap video will be posted to the Agency's social media accounts following the event.

Lastly, the Water in the Desert Art Show is scheduled to return for its third annual event this fall at the Joshua Tree Gallery of Contemporary Art. More information, including the application process, will be available soon.
