Registration open for Mojave Water Agency public workshop and tour

Apple Valley, CA — Registration is now open for Mojave Water Agency’s “The Need for Seed” workshop on Sept. 10 and the “MWA Roadshow” bus tour on Oct. 17.

As part of the Wonders of Water workshop series, “The Need For Seed” will feature Victor Valley College Professor of Agriculture, Neville Slade, who will discuss the importance of ecological restoration and the benefits of modern seed banks and collections. The event will take place at Agency Headquarters at 13846 Conference Center Drive, Apple Valley, CA 92307 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

All Wonders of Water sessions are free and designed to educate the public about the local water supply, science, conservation, or sustainability. Topics will range from family friendly presentations and activities to intermediate level scientific studies.
